Batam City is an industrial and international trade city bordering Singapore and Malaysia, making it a strategic area. The Batam City area consists of Batam Island, Rempang Island, Galang Island, and other small islands. The indigenous population has been inhabited by Malays, referred to as Orang Selat, since 231 AD. This island, which was once the battleground of Admiral Hang Nadim in his fight against the invaders, was used by the government in the 1960s as a logistics base for petroleum on Sambu Island. Currently, the city's population is also uniquely composed of people from various regions in Indonesia. Due to its diverse nature, Batam is also known for its various tourist attractions with cultural diversity and delicious culinary offerings.

### CONFERENCE VENUE

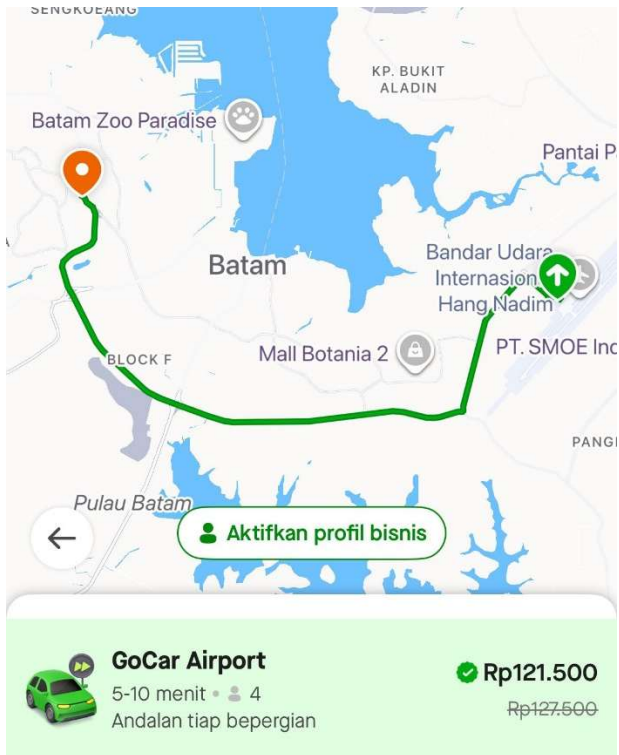

### TRANSPORTATION FROM HANG NADIM AIRPORT TO VENUE

Getting to downtown Batam from Hang Nadim Airport takes about 20 – 30 minutes, depending on traffic conditions. The accessible routes from Hang Nadim Airport to the event venue include:

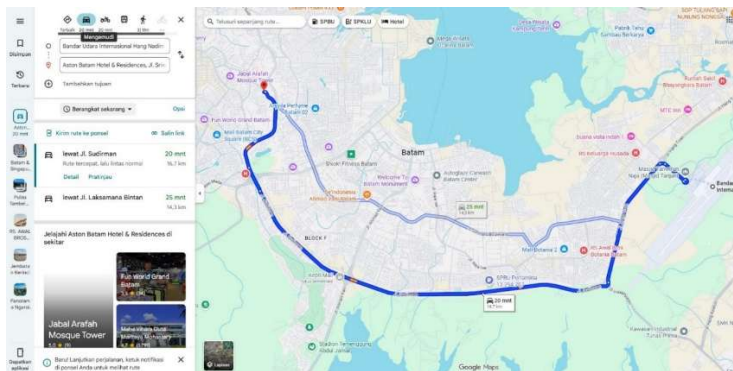
- **By Airport Taxi/Grab/Gojek/BlueBird**

Another popular alternative is to use a taxi or app-based transportation services like Grab, Gojek, Blue Bird, or other online taxis. This can be a convenient option, especially if you're carrying a lot of luggage or prefer a more personalized journey. The estimated cost of a Grab ride from Hang Nadim Airport to downtown Batam ranges from Rp121,000 to Rp150,000, depending on traffic and the route taken. A taxi or ride-hailing service typically takes about 20-30 minutes, depending on traffic conditions.



- **With Private Car**

If you have booked a pickup or have your own car, you can drive to Aston Batam Hotel & Residences with the help of a map or GPS.



### CLIMATE

Batam is experiencing climate change, with quite extreme weather. In November, Batam City enters the rainy season. The air temperature in Batam City ranges from 22°C to 33°C, with high air temperature and humidity in the morning and evening. The weather is cloudy from morning to afternoon in the area, with light rain, while the weather at nite is cloudy, with light rain in the Batam area. Daytime temperatures are warm to hot (over 30°C), while nites can feel cold. It is recommended to bring an umbrella and a jacket.
